Candlelight Service (Special Music by Rev. Eric Miletti and Wendie Roser)

As candles are being lit, the special music will be sung softly in the background; once all the candles are lit, the Pastor will begin the Candlelight Service liturgy. During the lighting of the candles, keep lit candles upright, tip only unlit candles.
