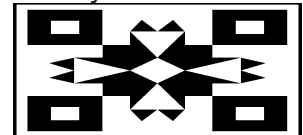

We enjoyed a gathering of fellowship and study on Thursday, August 4th. Pastor lead the lesson followed by our 4th video session of the Bible series.

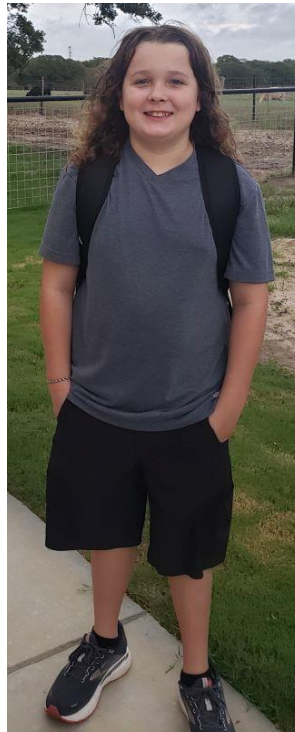

## August Council Meeting Highlights:

The Immanuel Lutheran Church Council met on August 15, 2022. Members present were: Pastor Eric Miletti, Jacy Reeves, Becca Reeves, Dianell Recker, Ronnie Coleman, Eric Fryer, Dwight Koepp, Rebe Penshorn, Randall Richter and Wendie Roser. Guests were Chrystal Coble, Gloria Kipp, and LaVerne Roskydal.

**Parishioners to be heard:** LaVerne Roskydal and Gloria Kipp addressed the Council; LaVerne has a contact name of someone to work on the outside of the church. (Have contractor get in touch with Eric Fryer.) She also talked about doing a spaghetti supper fundraiser and working with Thrivent to raise funds for the church.

**Correspondence:** There were donation requests from Water Mission, Wounded Warrior Project, and the Faith & Freedom Coalition, a lunch invitation from the Gideon's International, a flyer for Cross Trails Ministry's Fall Festival and a thank you for a \$250 donation, a pamphlet from India Transformed, and two emails about renting space for home schooling.

**Reports:** Minutes and treasurer's report were reviewed and accepted; Chrystal was available to answer questions regarding the financial report. **Pastor's Report** – Pastor said he should pick hymns in order to align them more to his sermon. He has noticed altar protocol is not what it should be and will use teaching moments so congregation knows what is expected. **President's Report** – In packet for review.

**Monthly Attendance;** 8/7 – Community Festival - 155 members / 44 visitors, 192 views on FBL; 8/14 – 105 members / 17 visitors, 33 views on FBL; 7/17 –107 members / 14 visitors, 19 views, 56 reached on FBL; 8/21 – 104 members / 25 visitors, 50 views on FBL; 8/28 –members / visitors, views on FBL.

### Old Business:

- Status of Submission of Constitution to NALC – Jacy said that we are still waiting for the NALC to accept our Constitution.
- Parish Hall Internet Status – Eric F. reported that the lines were installed incorrectly; working with Frontier Communications.
- New Building Phase 2 Quotes – Eric F. hasn't had time to work on this.
- Hall Rental Forms to be Updated – These will be sent out before the next meeting; Jacy asked that everyone please respond to the email.

### New Business:

- Vote on Vacant Officer Position(s) / Ministry Assignments – Motion made and passed to have Jacy Reeves as President, Rebecca (Becca) Reeves as Vice-President, Dianell Recker as Secretary, and Rebe Penshorn agreed to accept the ministry of Christian Education.
- Pastoral Compensation Package Update – Jacy Reeves, Chrystal Coble, and David Haass will meet to discuss compensation; Shelley Schulze from the NALC will provide guidance. After the negotiation meeting, Pastor has two weeks to agree to the package. Council will have a special meeting and a congregational meeting will be set.
- Audit Committee Formation – The following members were approved by the Council to serve on the Audit Committee – Brenda Willeford, Kelly Miller, and Taylor Witherell. A motion was made and passed to conduct an 18-month Internal Audit.
- Pastor said the back door of the church is being left unlocked. Eric F. will buy new doorknobs and have them replaced.
