HOPE: A GREAT GIFT



Here are a couple afterthoughts on Pastor Eric's sermon about the Parable of the Lost Sheep. We know we have an awesome God, and the Word reminds us of how great He is time and time again! Yet, when we are complaining and feeling sorry for ourselves, do we forget that Jesus is our only hope? Do we, in our self-pity, let our faith fall through the cracks and take us to the lowest, darkest moments of our existence? NO! We cannot do that! The parable tells us we are not lost; we have HOPE that our Shepherd will come after us and bring us back to the flock! Hope is a trust in God, knowing that He will not disappoint us. Hope is a building block of faith, "an assurance of what we do not see." (*Hebrews 11:1*) Hope is a gift that we receive when we accept his unending love.

Remember:

God never gives up on us: We are all like the lost sheep when we stray or are pulled away from God. We continue to sin; He keeps searching for us. We try to go our own way again. He opens up new doors and gives us another opportunity to come to Him. No matter how far away we go or how deep we fall, God is "always with us, even unto the end of the world." (*Matthew 28:20*)

God has mercy on those who ask forgiveness: In other words, He does not punish us for being sinners, He merely wants us to come to Him and believe. "There is great joy in heaven over one sinner that repents, more than over ninety-nine who need no repentance." (*Luke 15:7*) We therefore have hope and consolation that one day we will be united with Jesus.

We are saved by grace: *Ephesians 2: 8-9* tells us that we are not saved by our works, but by grace, and that this is a gift of God. Through grace we receive the undeserved favor of eternal life; we do not merit His goodness but have faith to let the Holy Spirit guide us. For Jesus Christ died on the cross for us so that we could have hope.

HOPE is the gift that we receive when we accept His unending love.

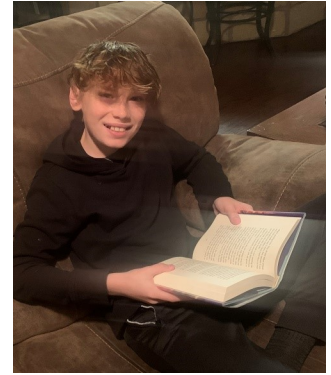

SEPTEMBER COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

The ILC Council met on September 20, 2022. Members present were: Pastor Eric Miletti, Jacy Reeves, Becca Reeves, Dianell Recker, Eric Fryer, Dwight Koepp, Rebe Penshorn, Randall Richter and Wendie Roser. Ronnie Coleman was absent. Guests were Chrystal Coble and Mark Buccigrossi.

Parishioners to be heard: Mark Buccigrossi regarding timeline of donations being moved from general account to sub accounts.

Correspondence: Emails from NALC thanking us for our donations, from the Children's Alliance of South Texas inviting us to their Trunk or Treat event on October 29th; donation requests from Water Mission, Wounded Warrior Project, Membership Program Solicitation to NAEIR, Cross Trails Ministry, and Lutheran Military Veterans and Families Ministries Inc.; and an invitation from India Transformed! for a virtual vision trip to India.

Reports: Minutes and treasurer's report were reviewed and accepted; Chrystal was available to answer questions regarding the financial report.

Pastor's Report: Pastor reported on new member class. He was elected Vice President of the Ministerial Alliance. Thanksgiving Community Service will be on November 20th. Pastor will visit Puerto Rico to distribute Wal-Mart cards to those affected by the hurricane. He presented proposed Peacemakers' fundraiser idea. He presented a teen/young adult mental health program that Samantha Kravitz wants to host at ILC—council accepted this proposal.

President's Report: The church has been rekeyed—any member needing a key to see the office or Jacy. She is still confirming bids from external audit companies.

Ministry Reports: Becca reported that she has been in contact with Renee about looking into new youth group shirts—more research to be completed. Jacy asked about status of internet line with Frontier Communications. A motion was made and passed to accept the disbursement recommendations made by the Festival Committee.

Old Business: There was no old business to discuss.

New Business:

Executive Session—Council went into executive session for a brief period to discuss and vote on special called meeting.

Sanctuary Door Viewer – Two more viewers are to be installed.

Calendar Updates – Tabled until October.

Update on Internal / External Audit - Answered internal audit committee questions to clarify dates and scope of audit. It was decided to start on general accounts first.

Security Waivers - Jacy has waivers for those who have taken the class with H. Schott. Background checks still need to be done.

New Building Update—Fundraising and Building Committees will be invited to the October Council meeting.

Updated Request Forms - Council discussed the need to update request forms for the office. Jacy will work on and submit for council and office review.

Updated Office Hours - Karen requested to be off on Thursdays. Council approved—Phones will be rerouted to Jacy on Thursdays.

Meeting adjourned and closed with prayer.
