The Importance of Christian Education in Summer for Children

But Jesus said, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven." And He laid His hands on them and departed from there.

Matthew 19:14-15

There is nothing more significant in the Bible than when the text quotes Jesus. The reason is that Jesus of Nazareth, for Christians, is "the author and finisher of our faith" (Hebrew 12:2), "in Him, we have redemption through His blood, the (and) forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace" (Ephesians 1:7), and He is God incarnate in our world (John1:1-3). Therefore, everything that Jesus says is imperative, not an option. The Bible should only be seen, read, and understood from Jesus' and His teachings' perspectives. According to Dr. Martin Luther, the Bible is Christ's cradle and swaddling clothes, as he writes in the third paragraph of his "Preface to the Old Testament," which appeared in 1523 and then again in 1545. So, for us as Christians and Lutherans, the Bible's whole reason is Jesus Christ.

This reasoning lies behind our efforts to reach and teach children about Jesus. Every summer at Immanuel Lutheran Church, we hold various events to fulfill Jesus' words in our church. If the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to everything that childhood represents, we must, without hesitation, try to match our preaching and living as we serve the children of La Vernia, a beautiful and unique part of the realm of God among us.

Today I want to invite the whole church: the traditional members, the new members, parents, youth, elderly, leaders, and even frequent visitors to unite under our determination to follow Jesus, as we will not depart from our summer plans without personally blessing the children with God's Word. Think seriously about how you can get involved, especially if you have never been part of our summer programs. Plan ahead of time to be there, to support with talents, time, and treasure. It is not just our responsibility but our calling from Jesus himself to proclaim and live the kingdom right here and right now.
